Dear Families,

Congratulations to our wonderful students for another outstanding week of learning and behaviour. This week we have been learning about being a positive learner in all areas of the school.

Our assemblies are a great place to celebrate our student's success in demonstrating our positive behaviour for learning values of being a learner, being respectful and being safe. Please come along and join us on a Thursday afternoon at 2:30pm. Make sure you sign in using the COVID app and the sign in book in the office.

Regular attendance at school is essential for your child to achieve their educational best and increase their career and life options. At Rous Public School we work in partnership with parents to encourage and support regular attendance of the children in our care. When your child attends school every day, learning



becomes easier and your child will build and maintain friendships with other children.

Arriving at school and class on time:

- Ensures that students do not miss out on important learning activities scheduled early in the day
- · Helps students learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- · Give students time to greet their friends before class
- Reduces classroom disruption. Lateness is recorded as a partial absence and must be explained by parents. If your child is absent from school or late to school a reason must be given.

At Rous Public School we provide many avenues for parents/carers to communicate with us about absences.

Families can:

- Message the teacher through DOJO (this is new and the classes will be introducing this as a form of communication in the coming weeks)
- Send a written note to the teacher
- Email the school
- Phone the school office.

Following an absence from school you must ensure that within 7 days you provide us with a verbal or written explanation for the absence. However, if we have not received an explanation from you within 2-3 days, we will make contact to discuss the absence.

Please remember that "every school day counts". If a student misses as little as 8 days in a school term, by the end of primary school they'll have missed over a year of school.

Afternoon pick up:

We are kindly asking that if your child is being picked up in the afternoon, can this please be done before 3:30 pm. We understand many parents have working commitments, however we really need this precious time to plan and prepare for the following day. The end of day ends at 3:10 pm. We are required to remain on site until 3:40, after this time staff are required to attend meetings and other professional

learning commitments. We greatly appreciate your understanding on this matter, as we need to work together as a team.

Our SRC met yesterday, worked on a list of exciting events for our students. The first fundraiser for the year will be a crazy hair and pyjama day **next Friday, 12 March**. We are asking for a gold coin donation. All funds will go towards a whole school reward at the end of each term.
