## Procedures for Late Arrivals and Early Leavers

**Late Arrivals** - Students arriving late to school **must be accompanied** to the office by a parent/carer or have a note signed by their parent/carer explaining why they are late.

**Early Leavers** - If your child needs to leave school before 3:10pm a valid explanation is required. Parents can provide a written note explaining why they need to leave or the parent/carer is required to present to the office and provide a valid reason.

**Students are not legally permitted** to pass on a message for siblings or explain their own absences. All absences will be marked as unexplained if parents have failed to provide an explanation to the school.
